Summary: Intergenerational Schools (IG Schools) are a model of three public K-8 schools serving 750 K-8 students in three distinct urban neighborhoods within the City of Cleveland, the majority of whom are socially and economically disadvantaged, and most of whom are African American or Hispanic. The Schools are committed to achieving their mission: to connect, create, and guide a multigenerational community of lifelong learners and spirited citizens as they strive for academic excellence. They do this through a unique educational model that incorporates multi-age classrooms, older adults, and shared learning experiences in the community.

POSITION OVERVIEW

The Intergenerational Schools are seeking substitute teachers to carry out the responsibilities of an absent teacher. Bachelor's Degree Required. Candidates are required to hold a valid state teaching license or substitute license.
