ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supporting teachers in their daily responsibilities (i.e. regular education classrooms in instruction, instructional materials, student records and classroom environment)
- Assists with the pre and post assessments of classroom children
- Maintains classroom routines and standards as established by the teacher
- Prepares instructional materials before and after class sessions
- Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to provide a productive classroom environment
- Communicates with parents and other concerned individuals on pupil progress
- Sit with the children during the meal periods to assist students with the serving and clean-up of the meal
- Works with small groups of students or 1:1 to reinforce academic or social-emotional skills
- Works under the direction of classroom teachers and intervention specialists.
- Maintains positive relationship with parents and students.
- Tutors individuals that need extra instruction
- Works with boundaries established by the teacher for discussing student's academic and behavioral issues with parents
- Other duties as assigned by School Leaders

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE
